Please ensure this form is signed by all property owners, or their Tenants, where HAYMAC are to install a timber or concrete wall plate mechanically fixed to the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post.

As part of your fencing or gate installation HAYMAC propose to install a wall plate to the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post. The installation of the new wall plate will be undertaken by drilling the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post using an 8mm masonry drill bit and fixing the wall plate using M8x 100mm (150mm) masonry fixings. If the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post of the building is in poor condition this may cause cracks in the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post.

We have assumed that the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post, that is to have the wall plate fixed to it, is in sound condition. Any damage to the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post during the installation of the wall plate will not be the financial responsibility of HAYMAC to repair or replace. Our installers will make every effort to avoid damage but sometimes this is unavoidable due to the unknown integrity of the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post. You will have been given an option within your quotation to exchange the wall plate for a fence or gate post installed directly into the ground to avoid damage to the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post. If you are not willing to accept the responsibility for the installation of the wall plate to the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post, please choose the alternative post installation option identified within your quotation.

It is the responsibility of the HAYMAC client to provide HAYMAC with this signed **HAYMAC Wall Plate Installation Damage Liability Waiver & Permission Form** prior to works commencing. Should this form not be completed, your work will **NOT proceed** with the installation of the wall plate, and you may have to choose the alternative post installation method for your installation with the associated additional costs identified within your quotation if you wish to proceed with the works to completion.

Damage Liability Waiver

- To allow your new fence or gate to be installed, replaced, or repaired in your garden, HAYMAC will install a wall plate mechanically fixed to the fabric of the building brickwork, blockwork, rendering, wall, fence or gate post. This signed HAYMAC Wall Plate Installation Damage Liability Waiver & Permission Form permits staff of HAYMAC to install the new wall plate without HAYMAC being held responsible any damage which may occur to the material fabric of the property brickwork, blockwork, rendering, garden wall, concrete fence or gate post.
- Signing this HAYMAC Wall Plate Installation Damage Liability Waiver & Permission Form confirms acceptance for the works to proceed as defined within this document.
