Please ensure this form is signed by all property owners, or their Tenants, where HAYMAC are to install a fence or gate post adjacent to, or through, a driveway, path, decking or patio.

As part of your fencing or gate installation HAYMAC propose to install new posts. The installation of the new posts will be undertaken by excavating adjacent to, or through, the driveway, path, decking or patio.

All buried services must be clearly identified where they cross the fence line, or run adjacent to the proposed fence line, with yellow marker paint and you must have completed our HAYMAC Buried Services Form. We cannot carry out any excavation works within 1.0m of any 'live' buried electrical service. Please isolate any electrical services which are within 1.0m of any of the post excavations required.

Any damage to the material fabric of the driveway, path, decking, patio or any unidentified or inadequately marked and identified buried service during the installation of the post will not be the financial responsibility of HAYMAC to repair or replace. Our installers will make every effort to avoid damage but sometimes this is unavoidable due to the unknown integrity of the material fabric of the driveway, path, decking or patio.

It is the responsibility of the HAYMAC client to provide HAYMAC with this signed **HAYMAC Post Installation Damage Liability Waiver & Permission Form** prior to works commencing. Should this form not be completed, your work will <u>NOT proceed</u>, and we will be unable to carry out your installation as detailed within your quotation.

Damage Liability Waiver

- To allow your new fence or gate to be installed or replaced, HAYMAC will install a new post by excavating adjacent to, or through, the driveway, path, decking or patio. This signed HAYMAC Post Installation Damage Liability Waiver & Permission Form permits staff of HAYMAC to install the new post without HAYMAC being held responsible for any damage which may occur to the material fabric of the driveway, path, decking, patio or any unidentified or inadequately marked and identified buried service.
- 2. Should damage occur during the installation of the new post to the material fabric of the driveway, path, decking, patio or any unidentified or inadequately marked and identified buried service, HAYMAC will not be responsible for any costs associated with the repair, replacement, or any consequential losses. Please ensure you have insurance in place which covers this activity.

Signing this HAYMAC Post Installation Damage Liability Waiver & Permission Form confirms acceptance for the works to proceed as defined within this document.
